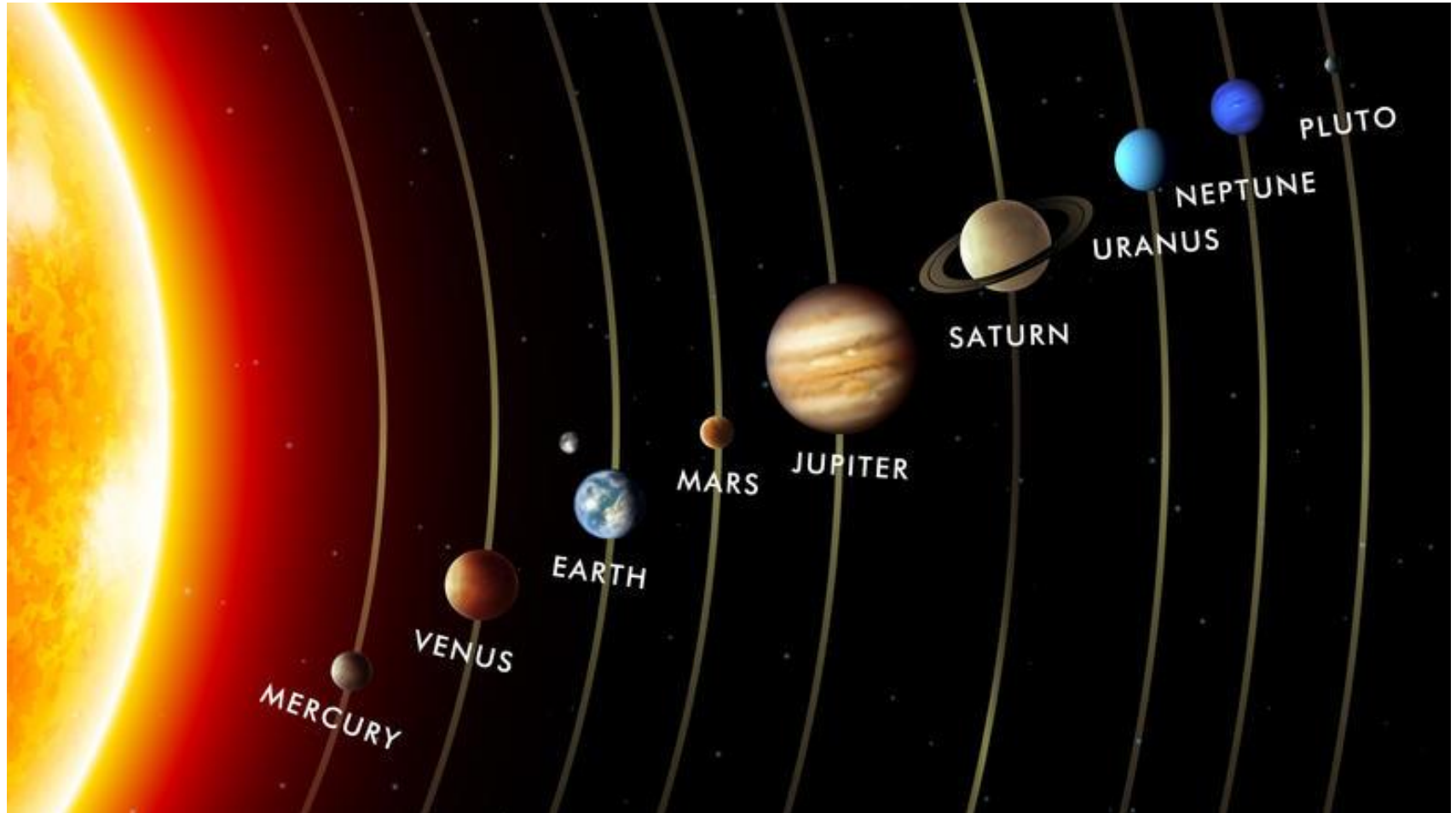


Neptune

Neptune: The Gas Giant



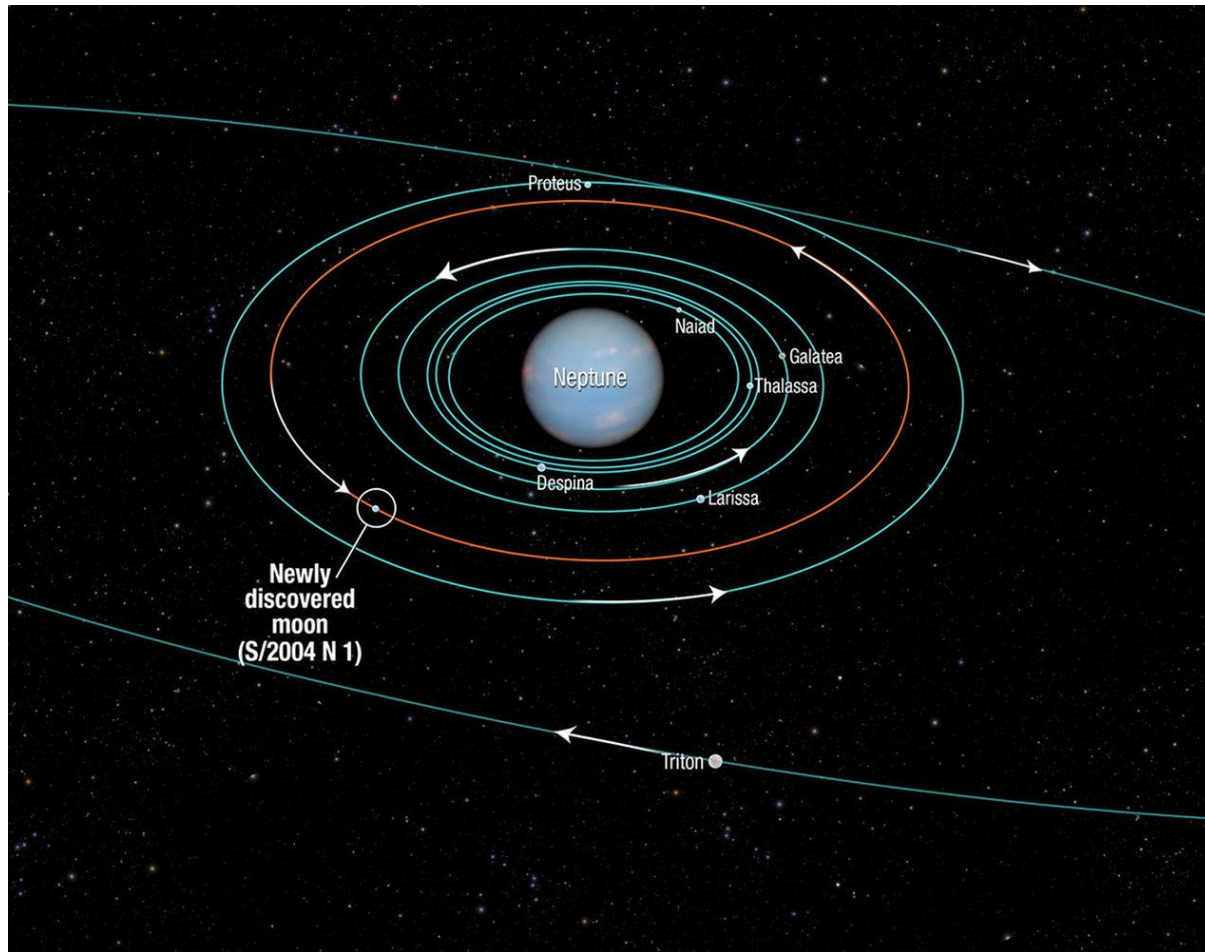

1846: Discovery of Neptune



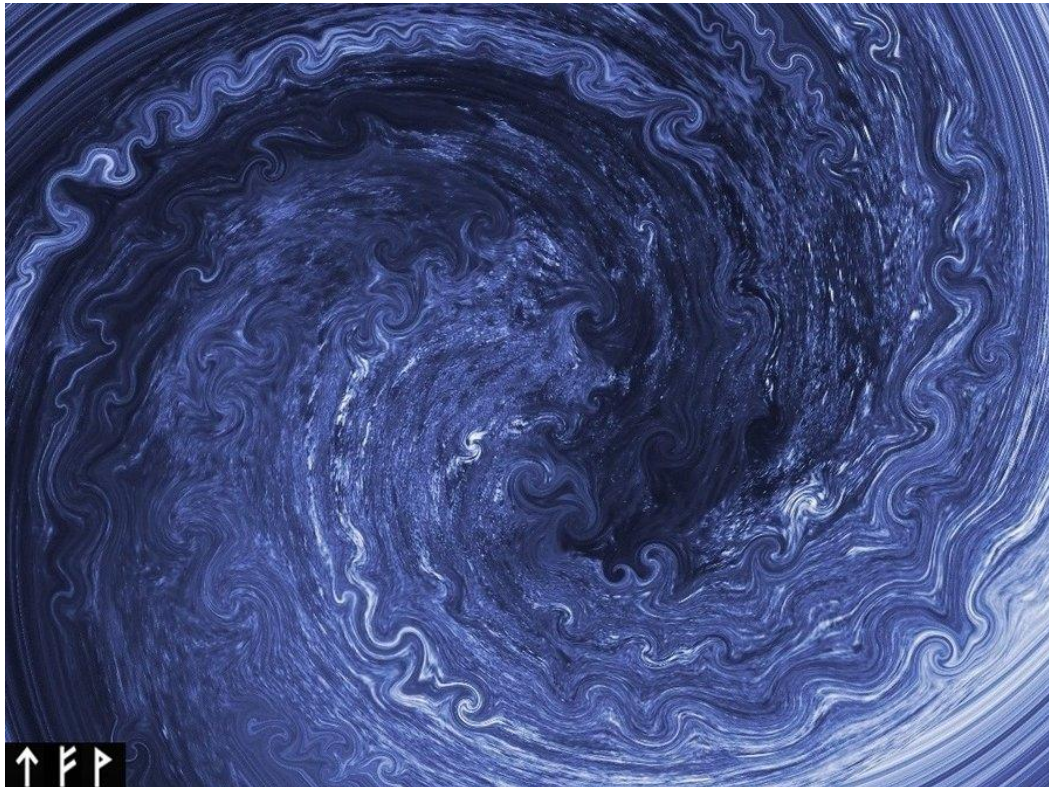
For many, centuries people did not know that this planet even existed. It was discovered by Johann Galle and Heinrich D'Arrest in 1846.
